**Applications are invited from the candidates through “ONLINE” only for admission to the Departmental Examinations to be held in DECEMBER 2019.**

Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has introduced One Time Registration from the Departmental Examinations December–2019. Hence, the candidates are required to furnish their particulars in One Time Registration. Necessary guidelines have been furnished in the Annexure-I of the Notification.

Applications from the candidates received in standardized/conventional method of application by handwritten or typed or roneo-ed or xerox-ed format will not be accepted and they will be rejected even if the cost of application is enclosed with them.

**General Information:**

1. The Departmental Examinations December - 2019 will be held as per the Revised Syllabus / Scheme / Pattern / type of examination as ordered by the Government in G.O. (Ms.) No.33, P&AR(M) Department, dated 02.03.2017.
2. The Application should be registered only through the Commission's website [www.tnpsc.gov.in](http://www.tnpsc.gov.in).
3. The candidates should note that Registration fee of Rs.30/- along with examination fee of Rs.200/- for each test should be **paid through online mode only using Net banking, Debit Card/ Credit card (payment through Challan will not be allowed/accepted).**
4. The candidates should use the **recent (not more than 3 months)** passport size photograph with **blue/white background with good clarity** for applying to the departmental examination.
5. The photo image should be of **165 x 125 pixels** and between 30-40 kb size and also the signature image should be of **80 x 125 pixels** and between 20 kb-30 kb size with reasonably good quality image.
6. **Selfie photos/Polaroid photos are not accepted for online application.** Applications not complying with these instructions or without clear photograph are liable to be rejected.

7. The candidates are required to upload their photo and signature in the appropriate boxes given in the online application.
8. The departmental examination commences from 9.30 am for the forenoon session and 2.30 pm for the afternoon session.
9. **All the candidates shall be present inside the examination hall at 9.00 a.m. for the forenoon session and 2.00 pm for the afternoon session. No candidate shall be allowed after 9.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. for the forenoon and afternoon sessions respectively.**
10. **The candidates will be supplied with the descriptive type answer booklets with preprinted personalized barcoding sheet containing all the details of the candidate attached to it.**
11. Hall ticket can be downloaded from the Commission's website from 17.12.2019 to 30.12.2019 by presenting the unique online Application Number and date of birth.
