2. From the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, Letter 3231/RND/C2/2002 dated 20/9/2002.

3. From the Inspector General of Prisons, Lt.No.71739/E1(3)/2000, dated 26.3.2003.

ORDER:

The Additional Director General of prisons in his letter first read above has stated that the nature of duties and responsibilities performed by the Prison Executive Staff are equally arduous and hazardous in nature as those performed by the Police personnel and all the Warders Grade I & II in Prison Department are treated equal to Grade I and II Police Constables in Police department for all intents and purposes and also prison warders continue to get most of the benefits extended to Police personnel by the Government from time to time. Hence, he has requested that 10% of the vacancies in the post of Assistant Jailor under the direct recruitment quota be reserved for the graduate Warders Grade I & II of the Prison Department as has been ordered in Police Department. In his letter third read above, the Additional Director General of prisons has sent necessary amendment to Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Jail and Subordinate Service.

2. The Government after careful examination have accepted the proposal of the Additional Director General of prisons to reserve 10% of the vacancies in the post of Assistant Jailor under the direct recruitment quota for the graduate Warders Grade I and II of the Prison Department and to amend the Special rule for Tamil Nadu Jail and Subordinate Service.

3. They accordingly direct that the following notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Jail Subordinate Service (Section 17 in volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual 1970).

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on the 27th May, 2004.

AMENDMENT.

In the said Special Rules, in part II, in Branch I- Executive Staff, in rule 2, the following proviso shall be added to sub-rule(e) namely :-

" Provided that not more than 10% vacancies of direct recruitment quota shall be filled up from the categories of Warders Grade I and Grade II of the Tamil Nadu Jail Subordinate Service, who are graduates and have put in five years of service in their respective categories".
