- ✓ Candidates belonging to Most Backward Classes / Denotified Communities and Backward Classes (other than Muslim) / Backward Classes (Muslim), who have passed the Pre-University Examination or in addition, the examination held at the end of the first or second year of the degree course or passed only certain parts of the degree examination are not exempted from payment of the prescribed fee.

1. The applicants who have not passed SSLC Examination or its equivalent are not eligible even if they possess a higher qualification.
2. Candidates claiming equivalence of qualification should produce evidence when called for.

* **Preference in Selection:**

In respect of appointment by direct recruitment to the post of Field Surveyor other things being equal, preference shall be given to the candidates with ITI qualification in survey.

(C) COMPUTER QUALIFICATION (for Typist and Steno-Typist, Grade III):-

Candidates should have passed the "Certificate Course in Computer on Office Automation" awarded by the Technical Education Department.

Note:

"Candidates who do not possess the said qualification (viz. Certificate Course in Computer on Office Automation) conducted by the Technical Education Department may also apply. If selected, they should acquire such qualification within the period of their probation".

(D) KNOWLEDGE OF TAMIL :-

Candidates should possess adequate knowledge of Tamil on the date of this Notification (as on 09.08.2016)

Note:

Candidates who do not possess an adequate knowledge in Tamil may also apply. If selected, they should pass the Second Class Language Test (Full Test) in Tamil within a period of two years from the date of their appointment, failing which they will be discharged from service.

(E) CERTIFICATE OF PHYSICAL FITNESS:-

Candidates selected for appointment to the posts will be required to produce a Certificate of Physical Fitness in the form prescribed below:-

Candidates with defective vision should produce eye fitness certificate from a qualified eye Specialist.

4. INFORMATION ON RESERVATION OF APPOINTMENTS:-

- i. The Rule of reservation of appointments applies to each post / unit separately. The Unit wise vacancies and Distribution of vacancies as per the rule in force will be announced later.
- ii. The Government have issued orders to fill up 20% of vacancies in direct recruitment on preferential basis to Persons Studied in Tamil Medium and illustration for PSTM turn vide G.O.Ms.No.145, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (S) Department, dated 30.09.2010. The 20% reservation of vacancies on preferential allotment to **Persons Studied in Tamil Medium (PSTM)** will apply for this recruitment. Now the Government have issued revised

illustration for PSTM turn vide G.O.Ms.No.40, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (S) Department, dated 30.04.2014 (Candidates claiming this reservation should have studied the prescribed qualification for the post in Tamil Medium and should have the certificate for the same. Having written the examinations in Tamil language alone will not qualify for claiming this reservation). If the candidates with PSTM are not available for selection for appointment against reserved turn such turn shall be filled up by Non-PSTM candidates but belonging to the respective communal category.

(For further details please refer para 29 (xix) of the Instructions to the candidates)

- iii. The number of vacancies advertised is only approximate and liable for modification with reference to vacancy position at any time before finalisation of selection.
- iv. If no qualified and suitable women candidates are available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, those vacancies will be filled by male candidates belonging to the respective communal categories.
- v. Regarding the vacancies available in the Department of Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments, only persons professing Hindu Religion are eligible.
- vi. 3% reservation for Differently Abled persons will apply for this recruitment. If no suitable Differently Abled person belonging to a particular Differently Abled Category is available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, it will be filled as per rule in force.
- vii. The Differently Abled person will be required to produce a certificate of physical fitness if he comes up for selection, from the Medical Board to the effect that his/her handicap will not render him/her incapable of efficiently discharging the duties attached to the post to which he/she has been selected, before appointment.
- viii. Reservation to "Destitute Widows" and "Ex-Servicemen" will apply for this recruitment. The G.Os regarding definition of Ex-Serviceman is available in Annexure-III. As per G.O(Ms) No.89 Personnel and Administrative Reform(S) Department dated 12.08.2015, **"In all cases, an Ex-serviceman once recruited to a post in any class or service or category, cannot claim the concession of being called an Ex-serviceman for his further recruitment"**. The G.Os regarding definition of Destitute Widow is available in Annexure-IV of this Notification.
- ix. Even after filling up of the posts reserved for SC Arunthathiyar on preferential basis, if more number of qualified Arunthathiyars are available, they shall be entitled to compete with the Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars in the inter-se merit among them and if any post reserved for Arunthathiyars remain unfilled for want of adequate number of qualified candidates, it shall be filled up by Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars.
- x. The selection for appointment to the above said posts is purely provisional subject to final Orders, on pending Writ Petitions, if any, filed in Madras High Court and Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.
- xi. **Applications containing wrong claims relating to communal categories/age/ educational qualification will be liable for rejection.**

Note :

- Two types of question papers will be set. One type of question paper will contain questions on General Studies (75 items) + Aptitude Test (25 items) and General English (100 items). The other will contain questions on General Studies (75 items) + Aptitude Test (25 items) and General Tamil (100 items). Candidates are given the option to choose either General Tamil or General English for answering the second 100 items apart from answering the first (75+25)100 items on General Studies and Aptitude Test.
- The questions on General Studies will be set both in English and Tamil and the questions on General Tamil/ General English will be set in the respective languages.
- The syllabi for the above subject is available in the Commission's Website 'www.tnpsc.gov.in' and also in Annexure-II of this notification.**

Note :(2) Instruction to candidates appearing for Objective type Examination :

- To use either blue or black ink Ball Point pen only.
- Answer sheet will be invalidated if shaded in pencil.
- The answer sheet will be invalidated if the box provided for booklet series mentioned in the Question Paper is not shaded / in correctly shaded.
- Answer sheet answered in a subject other than the subject opted by the candidates in his application / specified in the Hall Ticket will be invalidated.
- One mark will be deducted for incorrect or absence of shading Register Number.

6. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION :-

Based on the marks obtained by the candidates in the Written Examination, the tentative list of eligible candidates for certificate verification will be announced in the Commission's website. After verification of the original certificates, the eligible candidates will be summoned for counselling to allot the post and Department in the order of rank and category to which they are eligible as per the vacancy position.

TYPIST AND STENO-TYPIST, Grade III:-

- a) Candidates with technical qualification referred to in item (i) under para 3(B) (II) will be selected.
- b) In case candidates with technical qualification referred to in item (i) under para 3(B) (II) are not available, candidates with technical qualification referred to in item (ii) under para 3(B) (II) will be selected.
- c) In case candidates with technical qualification referred to in item (i) and (ii) under para 3(B) (II) are not available, candidates with technical qualification referred to in item(iii) under para 3(B) (II) will be selected.

7. SECURITY:-

Candidates to be selected for appointment as Junior Assistant (Security) (or) Bill Collector should pay the security amount as may be prescribed by the appointing authority concerned at the time of appointment.

8. MODE OF PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEE:-

- Examination fee Rs.75/- (Rupees Seventy five only)
- Candidates have to register their basic particulars through One-Time Registration which is mandatory on payment of Rs.50/- towards registration fee. The registration shall be valid for a period of five years from the date of one-time registration.
- Candidates should also pay the service charges applicable to the Bank or Post Office.
- Candidates can avail exemption from paying Examination Fees as per eligibility criteria.
- **Offline mode of payment in the form of DD/Postal Order etc., will not be accepted and the applications forwarded with such modes of payment will be summarily rejected.**
- Those who have already registered in the **one time** registration system and paid the registration fee of Rs.50/- and received the registration ID **need not pay** the application fee i.e. Rs.50/- and it is enough to pay the Examination Fee of Rs.75 alone.
- Candidates who have made **one time registration must apply for this post also**. One time registration is only to avail exemption for application fee for a period of 5 years from the date of registration.

9. NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE AND INFORMATION TO THE EMPLOYER:-

11. CENTRES FOR EXAMINATION:-

The Written Examination will be held at the Centres mentioned in Annexure–I of this Notification.

Note:

- i. Candidates should appear for the Examination / Certificate Verification and Counselling at their own expenses.
- ii. Request for change of venue will not be complied with.
- iii. The Commission reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of examination venues and to re-allot the candidates.

12. GENERAL INFORMATION:-

- a. **Candidates should ensure their eligibility for examination:** The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions on the date of this notification for admission to examination. **Their admission to all stages of the examination will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions.** Mere issue of memo of admission to the candidate will not imply that his/her candidature has been fully cleared by the Commission.
- b. The original certificate for any claim relating to the selection (not related to candidature or / and claims made in the application) should be produced when called for. Any claim received thereafter will not be considered.
- c. Information regarding arrest, convictions/debarment/disqualification by any recruiting agency, criminal (or) any disciplinary proceedings initiated or finalized, participation in agitation (or) any Political Organization, candidature in election for Parliament/ State Legislature/Local Bodies etc., if any, should also be furnished to the Commission.
- d. The Hall Tickets for eligible candidates will be made available in the Commission's Website **www.tnpsc.gov.in** (or) **www.tnpscexams.net** for downloading by candidates. **No Hall Tickets will be sent by post.** So the candidates should watch Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission website before the scheduled date of examinations.
- e. **Facilitation Counter for guidance of candidates:** In case of any guidance / information/ clarification of their applications, candidature, etc. candidates can contact Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission's Office in person (or) over Telephone No. 044-25332833/25332855 (or) the Commission's Office Toll-Free No. 1800 425 1002 on all working days between 10.00 a.m. and 05.45 p.m.
- f. **Mobile Phones and other Articles Banned:-**
 - (i) Candidates are not allowed to bring Cellular Phone, Calculator, Memory Notes and books etc. (or) any other Electronic device (or) Recording Device either as separate piece (or) part of something used by the candidate such as Watch (or) Ring.
 - (ii) If they are found to be in possession of any such thing (or) instrument they will not be allowed to write the examination further, besides invalidation of answer paper and / (or) debarment. If it is considered necessary they will be subjected for a physical search including frisking on the spot.
 - (iii) Do not bring into the Examination Hall any article such as books, notes, loose sheets mathematical and drawing instruments, Log Tables, stencils of maps, slide rules, Text Books, rough sheets etc. except the permitted writing material i.e. pen. **No colour pen (or) pencil must be used.**

- g.** Candidates are not required to submit along with their application any certificates in support of their claims regarding Age, Educational Qualifications, Community Certificates and certificates regarding their Physical Disability, etc., They should be submitted when called for by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the Examination. Their admission at all the stages of examination for which they are admitted by the Commission viz. Written Examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification at any time before or after the written Examination, it is found that they do not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the Commission.
- h.** If any of their claims is found to be incorrect, or false it will lead to rejection / debarment for certain period decided by Commission.
- i.** **Unfair means strictly prohibited:-** No candidate shall copy from the papers of any other candidate nor permit his papers to be copied nor give nor attempt to give nor obtain nor attempt to obtain irregular assistance of any description. If any such malpractice is found it will lead to debarment of the candidate for certain period decided by Commission.
- j.** **Conduct in Examination Hall:-** No candidate should misbehave in any manner (or) create a disorderly scene in the Examination Hall (or) harass the staff employed by the Commission for the conduct of the examination. Any such misconduct will be severely viewed and penalised.

Ever since the orders defining the term "Ex-servicemen" issued in the Government Order first read above, there have been several changes and clarifications issued to the term "Ex-servicemen". It has also been noticed that in certain Government Departments, the old form of definition is still being followed which results in denial of concessions/facilities to the genuine Ex-servicemen and some ineligible persons who do not come under the definition get the benefits extended to Ex-servicemen. Hence it is considered necessary to issue consolidated orders for defining "Ex-servicemen" incorporating all the amendments/clarifications issued so far in this regard.

2. Accordingly, the Government direct that the following definitions be made applicable to personnel who retired on or before 30.06.1968, between 01.07.1968 and 30.06.1972 (both days included) between 01.07.1972 and 30.06.87 (both days included) and on or after 1.07.1987. The Departments or Secretariat are directed to make necessary amendment in their respective rules accordingly.

(i) Those released on or before 30.06.68:

Any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union and has been released therefrom otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency.

- (ii) Those released between 1.7.68 and 30.6.79 (both days included.)

Any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union for a continuous period of not less than six months after attestation and released therefrom otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency.

- (iii) Those released between 01.07.79 and 30.06.87 (both days included):

Any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union for a continuous period of not less than six months after attestation if discharged for reasons other than at their own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and not less than 5 years of service if discharged at his own request.

- (iv) Those released on or after 01.07.87:

Any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Indian Union and was released/retired with any kind of pension from Defence Budget or released on completion of specific terms of engagement with gratuity otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency.

- (v) The personnel of Territorial Army (TA) of the following categories viz. pension holders for continuous embodied service persons with disability attributable to military service and gallantry award winners retired on or after 15.11.86.

3. The personnel of the Army Postal Service (APS) who are a part of the Regular Army and retire from such service. (i.e. directly from the Army Postal Service itself without reversion to P&T Department) with pension or who have been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension are also covered within the definition of Ex-Servicemen with effect from 19.07.89.

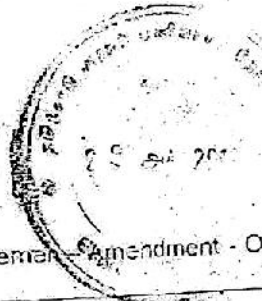

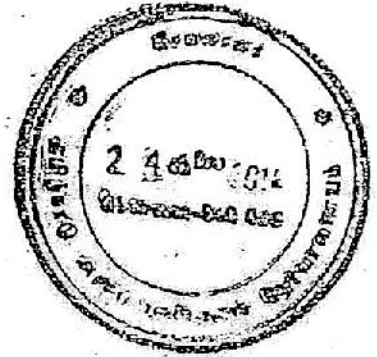

- (d) any person who had served in any rank (whether as Combatant or not) in the Armed Forces of the Union, and had retired or had been released on or after 1st July 1987 from such service,-

 - (ii) on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
 - (iii) otherwise than at his own request after earning his pension, as a result of reduction in establishment; or
 - (iv) after completing specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity.

NOTES:

In the G.O. second read above, after carefully considering a question of relaxing any technical restrictions including age limit prescribed in the Service Rules in favour of "destitute widows", the following revised instructions were issued in the matter giving preference to 'destitute widows' in the appointment to Public Services:-

- (a) Special consideration shall be given to the destitute widows for appointment to all posts in Government service, local bodies and Government aided institutions, provided the candidates fully satisfy the qualification rule and are otherwise eligible on merits; the word "special consideration" denotes that when other things are equal, destitute widows should be preferred over others who are also competitors for a particular post;

- (b) Same age limit as prescribed for Scheduled Caste candidates shall be made applicable for destitute widows of all castes;
- (c) Special consideration shall also be given to the destitute widows for admission to the training institutions provided they satisfy the educational requirements prescribed under the rules and are otherwise eligible on merits;
- (d) The expression "destitute widows" is defined as one who has neither any means by herself to live nor any dependant to protect her from starvation.

In the G.O. 3rd read above, orders were issued amending General Rule 12(d) for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services, wherein a concession has been given to certain castes, to include destitute widows of all castes, also in the said concession and adding an explanation thereunder that "for the purpose of this sub-rule 'destitute widow' means a widow who has neither any means by herself to live nor any dependant to protect her from starvation". This amendment came into force from 31st July, 1937. Subsequently, in the G.O. 4th read above, after General Rule 55, a new rule i.e. General Rule 56 was added with the same explanation given under General Rule 12(d), as below -

"56. Employment concession for destitute widows:-

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules or the Special rules for the various State and Subordinate Services, preference shall be given to the destitute widows who possess the qualifications prescribed for appointment to any post under the State Government by direct recruitment.

Explanation:- For the purpose of this rule, "destitute widow" means a widow who has neither any means by herself to live nor any dependant to protect her from starvation."

2. The Government have considered in detail the question of redefining the term "destitute widow" and to delete the explanations in General rules 12(d) and 56. The following revised instructions are accordingly issued:-

I. DEFINITION OF "DESTITUTE WIDOW":-

The term "destitute widow" is hereby defined as a widow whose total monthly income from all sources is not more than Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) including any family pension or other receipts including income from private practice in the case of professionals. A divorcee will not, however, be treated as a "widow".

II. FORMAT AND COMPETENT AUTHORITY FOR ISSUE OF CERTIFICATE TO CANDIDATES CLAIMING TO BE "DESTITUTE WIDOW".

The format for issue of the certificate to candidates claiming to be "destitute widows" is appended to this order. The Revenue Divisional Officer, is empowered to issue such a certificate.

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III. APPLICABILITY OF RULE OF RESERVATION:-

Destitute widows who do not get selected against open vacancies (i.e. vacancies not reserved for women) or Open Competition turn with reference to their marks in the relevant Competitive examination/interview, as the case may be, will be considered only under women's quota of 30 per cent of vacancies in Public Service. Destitute widows who belong to other communities and who possess the prescribed qualifications and are found to be fit by passing the competitive examination by getting the minimum qualifying marks shall be selected for vacancies reserved for women under the O.C. turn in preference to other women eligible for selection to the said O.C. turn even though the other women might have secured higher marks. Similarly, the destitute widows belonging to the respective reservation categories, i.e. Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes/Notified Communities and Backward Classes who possess the prescribed qualifications and are found to be fit by passing the competitive examination by getting the minimum qualifying marks and who do not get selected against open vacancies or O.C. turn as mentioned above shall be selected for vacancies reserved for women belonging to the respective reservation category even though other women of the same reservation category might have secured higher marks. In other words, the communal rotation should not be affected by the preference given to the destitute widows and there is no reservation for destitute widows. A destitute widow belonging to one reservation category cannot, however, be selected against a vacancy meant for another reservation category.

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3. Amendments to Rules 12(d) and 56 of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services will be issued separately. Until the rules are amended, the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission is requested to decide the pending cases with reference to the provisions in the existing rules.

ORDER:

As per the Explanation I to rule 12(d) of the General Rules for Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules, destitute widow shall mean a widow whose total monthly income from all sources shall not be more than Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) including any family pension or other receipts including income from private practice in the case of professionals, but shall not include a divorcee. In its letter read above, the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has requested the Government to enhance the above income ceiling from Rs.1000/- to Rs.4000/- in view of the rise in prices and increase in the basic pay of the Government servants.

2. The Government have examined the request of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in detail and have decided to accept it. They accordingly direct that the total monthly income limit prescribed for destitute widows be enhanced from Rs.1000/- to Rs.4000/-

3. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the General Rules in Part II of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules (Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1987).

ORDER

As per proviso of Rule 21 of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services, in the case of direct recruitment to the posts with Grade pay which does not exceed Rs.2400/-, ten percent of vacancies out of thirty percent vacancies set apart for women shall be set apart for destitute widows. In the Government order second read above, revised orders were issued among others enhancing the Grade pay attached to the post of Assistant in all Government departments from Rs.2400/- to 2800/-.

2. In the letter third read above, the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has informed that reservation for Destitute Widow has to be extended to the posts for which the Grade pay has been enhanced from Rs.2400/- to 2800/- as per the orders issued in Government Order second read above, and the reservation for Destitute Widow has been announced in the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission notification and requested that necessary executive orders giving effect from 01.01.2006 may be issued so as to validate the notification issued on 30.12.2010.

3. The Government have examined the request of the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in detail and have decided to issue necessary amendment to the proviso to Rule 21 of General Rules of Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services.

4 Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette :-
