

Sub: Recruitment (Direct) – Post of Assistant Conservator of Forests in the Tamil Nadu Forest Service – Call for Physical Test to the candidates – Regarding.

As per the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission instructions, the Physical verification test and walking test for the post of Assistant Conservator Forests is scheduled to be conducted at Arignar Anna Zoological Park, Vandalur on the following dates for which the candidates are advised to report on the said dates.

Physical standards (vide Para 6 (c) of the commission notification no 21/2017 dt.12.09.2017)

The candidates are must possess the following minimum Physical standards:-

In case of candidates belonging to Schedule Tribes and races such as Assamese, Bhutanese, Gatiwalis, Gorkhas, Kumaonis, Ladakhese, Mizo, Naga, Napalese, Sikkimese and those from Arunachal Pradesh, Lahaul and Spiti and Maghalalya are required the following minimum height. **They are requested to bring community certificates for availing this concession.**

Male Candidates - 152 cm

Female Candidates - 145 cm

2. The candidates are requested to produce the physical qualification certificate (model enclosed) as mentioned in para 6 (c) of the Commission notification. The candidates only those who clear the physical qualification will be allowed to participate in the walking test to be conducted on 19.03.2019.

3. The male candidates will have to walk 25 kms in four hours and female candidates will have to walk 16 kms in four hours.

4. The candidates are advised to keep themselves fit for the walking test. They are also advised to bring good walking shoes and attire suitable for walking.

5. Adequate First Aid arrangements, water, lemon and glucose will be provided to the candidates.

6. The management of the Arignar Anna Zoological Park will not bear any responsibility for the injuries sustained during the walking test.

7. Any malpractices in the walking test will result in summary rejection of their candidatures.

8. The candidates are asked to submit a Bio-data sheet (copy of the Bio-data for the candidate is enclosed herewith).

9. The candidates are requested to bring the following on 18.03.2019

- (i) 2 passport size photos,
- (ii) Copy of TNPSC hall ticket,
- (iii) Copy of this call letter
- (iv) Duly filled bio-data form attested by any one of the Gazetted Officers not below the Rank of Group B officers from any Government Departments.
- (v). The physical qualification certificate should be obtained from a Medical officer of / or above the rank of an Assistant Surgeon appointed by the Government to a Government Medical Institution.

10. The candidates are permitted to bring their mobile phone or smart watch during the walking test.


11. The candidates will not be allowed for any change of the date and venue of the physical verification test and walking test.
