**4. GENERAL INFORMATION :-**

- The Rule of reservation of appointments is applicable to this post and the distribution of vacancies will be as per rule in force.
- The number of vacancies advertised is only approximate and is liable to modification with reference to vacancy position at any time before finalisation of selection for Oral Test or selection for appointment, as the case may be.
- If no qualified and suitable woman candidates are available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, those vacancies will be filled by male candidates belonging to the respective communal categories.
- CERTIFICATE OF PHYSICAL FITNESS:** Candidates selected for appointment to the post will be required to produce a certificate of physical fitness in the form prescribed for '**Executive Post**'. The Standard of vision prescribed for the post is '**Standard- III**' or '**Better**'. Candidates with defective vision should produce eye fitness certificate from qualified eye specialist.
- Reservation of appointment to "Destitute Widows" and "Ex-servicemen" will not apply to this recruitment
- Any claim relating to the selection (not related to candidature or/and claims made in the application) made by the candidate, who had written the examination should be received within 90 days from the date of announcement of results and any claim received thereafter will receive no attention.

**5. QUALIFICATIONS: -****(A) AGE (as on 01.07.2010):****MAXIMUM AGE LIMIT – Should not have completed 35 years****Note:**

- (1) No maximum age limit for SCs, STs, MBCs/DCs, BCs(Other than BCMs), , BCMs and Destitute Widows of all castes.
- (2) Age relaxation of 5 years in the maximum age limit will be applicable to persons affected by the ban order as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.98,P&AR(S) Department, dated 17.07.06 and G.O.Ms.No.152, P&AR(S) Department, dated 18.09.06 and subsequent clarifications thereon.
- (3) Candidates not belonging to SCs,STs, MBCs/DCs, BCs (Other than BCMs), BCMs (i.e. 'others') who have put in five years of service in the State/Central Government are not eligible to apply, even though they are within the age limit.

**(B) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

Candidates should possess the following or its equivalent qualification on the date of this Notification, viz.17-02-2010:

- (i) Master's degree in Library Science or Information Science or Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree with not less than fifty five percentage of marks or its equivalent grade, where grading system is practiced and a consistently good academic record with knowledge on computerization of Library; and
- (ii) Pass in the National Eligibility Test (NET) or other accredited test like State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) in Library Science conducted for the purpose by the University Grants Commission or any other agency approved by the University Grants Commission.

Provided that a person who is or has been awarded a Ph.D Degree through a process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the University Grants Commission (Minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D Degree ) Regulation 2009, is exempted from passing the above tests"

- i. Candidates should choose any one of the above centres and appear for the examination at their own expenses.

**8. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:-**

Selection will be made in two successive stages i.e., (i) Written Examination and (ii) Oral Test in the shape of an interview. Final selection will be made on the basis of the total marks obtained by the candidates at the Written Examination and Oral Test taken together subject to the rule of reservation of appointments. Candidate's appearance both in the Written Examination and Oral Test is compulsory. A candidate who has not appeared for the Oral Test will not be considered for selection, even if he/she secures qualifying marks in the Written Examination. (For further details please refer paragraph 22(b) of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates').

**9. EXAMINATION FEE:** Rs.125/- (Rupees One hundred and twenty five only)

Examination fee should be paid only through any one of the Post Offices listed in Annexure – III to the Brochure and the Postal Receipt obtained for the payment of fee should be pasted in the space provided in the application. (For further details refer para. 2 under part –III of Information Brochure and for Examination fee concessions, refer para 12 of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates'). All candidates should pay Rs. 5/- (Rupees five only) as service charge to the Post Office, while obtaining the Postal Receipt. - C. Candidates should use only the OMR application form. No other typed or printed or Xeroxed / Photocopy of the application form will be accepted and such application, if any received, will be summarily rejected.

Candidates claiming exemption from payment of Examination fee should possess and keep ready Postal Receipt for Rs.30/- towards the application fee.
