Applications are invited upto 5.45 p.m on 06-05-2009 for direct recruitment to the vacancies for the years 2007-2008 in the following post:-

3. GENERAL INFORMATION :-

- A. The Rule of reservation of appointments is applicable to this post and the distribution of the vacancies will be as per the rule in force
- B. The number of vacancies advertised is only approximate and is liable to modification with reference to vacancy position at any time before finalisation of selection for Oral Test or selection for appointment, as the case may be.
- C. If no qualified and suitable woman candidates are available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, those vacancies will be filled by male candidates belonging to the respective communal categories.
- D. **CERTIFICATE OF PHYSICAL FITNESS:-**
Candidates selected for appointment to the post will be required to produce a certificate of physical fitness in the form prescribed for “**Executive Posts**”. The Standard of vision prescribed for the post is ‘**Standard- I**’.
- E. 3% reservation for Physically Handicapped persons, “Destitute Widows” and ‘Ex-Servicemen’ will not apply to this recruitment.
- F. Any claim relating to the selection (not related to candidature or/and claims made in the application) should be received within 90 days from the date of announcement of results. Claims received thereafter will receive no attention.
- H. Candidates belonging to Backward Class Muslims, (i.e. BCMs) should fill-up Columns 6, 7 and 7(a) of the OMR application form and shade the boxes thereunder. All the concessions/ relaxations / benefits applicable to BC candidates are applicable to BCM candidates also.
- I. The expression “BC”.(i.e. Backward Class) wherever it occurs in the Commission’s ‘Instructions, etc. to candidates’, ‘Information Brochure’ and OMR application form, should be read as “BC(Other than BCM) and BCM”.

4. QUALIFICATIONS: -

(A) AGE (as on 01.07.2009) :

Minimum Age Limit : Should have completed 18 years (for all candidates).

Maximum Age Limit : Should not have completed 30 years. Should not have completed 35 years in the case of persons who possess Master's degree in Criminology and Criminal Justice Administration or Master's degree in Social Work.

- (i) No age limit for SCs, STs, MBCs/DCs, BCs (other than BCMs), BCMs and DWs for all castes.
- (ii) Age relaxation of 5 years in the maximum age limit will be applicable to persons affected by the ban order, as per the orders of the Government.
- (iii) Candidates not belonging to SCs., STs., MBCs/DCs, BCs (Other than BCMs) and BCMs (i.e. 'others') who have put in five years of service in the State/Central Government are not eligible to apply even though they are within the age limit.

(B) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:-Candidates should possess the following or its equivalent qualification on the date of this Notification viz. **03-04-2009**

A Degree of B.A. or B.Sc. or B.Com. of any University or Institution recognised by the University Grants Commission for the purpose of its grant or B.O.L. of Annamalai University or B.B.A. of Madurai Kamaraj University or B.Litt. of Madras University or B.B.M or B.Litt. of Bharathiar University.

Other things being equal, first preference shall be given to persons possessing Master's degree in Criminology and Criminal Justice Administration and second preference shall be given to persons possessing Master's degree in Social Work.

Persons claiming equivalence of qualification should enclose evidences for such claims.

(C) PHYSICAL QUALIFICATION:-

- (i) **For Male Candidates** : Must be not less than 165 cms in Height and not less than 81 cms round the chest on full expiration and must have a chest expansion of not less than 5 cms on full inspiration.

For Female Candidates: Must be not less than 155 cms in Height. The Chest measurement will not apply to them.

Provided that the male candidates who belong to S.C or S.T must have a minimum Height of 160 cms. and a chest measurement of 79 cms. on full expiration with an expansion of not less than 5 cms. on full inspiration and the female candidates who belong to S.C or S.T must have minimum Height of 150 cms..

- (ii) Must satisfy the Medical Board in Tamil Nadu as to his/her physique, fitness and capacity for active outdoor work.
- (iii) Must be certified by the Superintendent of Government Ophthalmic Hospital, Chennai.

Note:

- (i) The question paper will be set in two types (i.e.) 1) General Knowledge (100 questions) with General Tamil (100 questions) and 2) General Knowledge (100 questions) with General English (100 questions). The candidates are given the option to choose either General Tamil or General English for answering the second 100 questions apart from answering the first 100 questions on General Knowledge. The candidates should mention in the column 22 of the OMR application form the option (i.e. General Tamil or General English) chosen by them, failing which they will be penalised.
- (ii) The questions on "General Knowledge" will be set both in Tamil and in English and the questions on General Tamil and General English will be set in the respective languages.
- (iii) Minimum qualifying marks for selection for SCs., STs., MBCs/DCs, BCs(other than BCMs) and BCMs is 102/340 and for 'Others' 136/340.

6. CENTRES FOR EXAMINATION: Examination will be held in the following 9 Centres. The names of the Centres and Centre Codes are as follows:-

Note:- Candidates should choose anyone of the above centres and appear for the examination of their own expenses. Request for change of centre will not be complied with. The Commission reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of examination centres and to re-allot the candidates.

7. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:- Selection will be made in two successive stages i.e., (i) Written Examination and (ii) Oral Test in the shape of an interview. Final selection will be made on the basis of the total marks obtained by the candidates at the Written Examination and Oral Test taken together subject to the rule of reservation of appointments. Candidate's appearance both in the Written Examination and Oral Test is compulsory. A candidate who has not appeared for the Oral Test will not be considered for selection, even if he/she secures qualifying marks in the Written Examination. (For further details please refer paragraph 22(b) of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates').

8. EXAMINATION FEE:- Rs.125/- (Rupees One Hundred and twenty five only)

Examination fee should be paid only through any one of the Post offices listed in Annexure – III to the Brochure. (For further details refer para 2 under part –III of Information Brochure and for Examination fee concessions, refer para 12 of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates').

9. ENCLOSURES TO BE SENT ALONG WITH APPLICATION:- Copies of all certificates as mentioned in para 15 of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates' and item 25 under part–II of Information Brochure along with a Postal Receipt to the value of Rs.125/- pasted in the column provided in the application, unless exemption of fee is claimed. Information relating to debarment by any recruiting agency, criminal or any disciplinary proceeding initiated or finalised should be furnished along with the application. **Original Certificates should not be sent.** Those applying Online please refer sub para D of Para 12 of this Notification/Advertisement.

Applications received without the attested copies of certificates as specified above will be rejected.

10. NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE :For details please refer to paragraph 15(g) of the 'Instructions, etc. to Candidates'.

11. CONCESSIONS:- Concessions in the matter of age and/or fees allowed to SCs., STs., MBCs/DCs., BCs(Other than BCMs), BCMs, Destitute Widows, Ex-Servicemen, Physically Handicapped persons, discharged and serving temporary State Government employees below 40 years of age, etc. are given in the Commission's 'Instructions, etc. to candidates'.

12. ISSUE OF APPLICATION FORMS: -

- A. - B. OMR application forms can also be obtained in person from the sales counter of the office of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, Omathoor Government Estate, Chennai-600 002, on all the working days till the closing date upto 5.00 p.m. (excluding lunch interval between 1.30 and 2.00 p.m.) only on cash payment of Rs.30/- **Application forms will not be supplied to the candidates by Post.**
- C. Candidates should use only the OMR application form (AD or subsequent series). No other typed or printed or Xeroxed / Photocopy of the application form will be accepted and such application, if any received, will be summarily rejected.
- D. Candidates can also avail of the facility of applying Online on the Commission's Website at www.tnpsc.gov.in. Candidates applying Online should possess and keep ready Postal Receipt for Rs.155/- (i.e. Application fee Rs.30/- and Examination fee Rs. 125/-) obtained from any one of the Post Offices listed in Annexure-III to the Information Brochure before registering Online. Candidates claiming exemption from payment of Examination fee should possess and keep ready Postal Receipt for Rs.30/- towards the application fee. The Postal Receipt obtained for the payment of Application Fee/ Examination Fee should be pasted in the space provided in the application. Candidates applying Online shall also abide by the Commission's instructions laid down in this Notification / Advertisement/Commission's 'Instructions, etc. to candidates' / Information Brochure. Candidates applying Online should send their applications (i.e. The printout

generated from the web site and signed by the candidate) with the Postal Receipt along with attested copies of Certificates so as to reach the Commission's office on or before the last date for receipt of applications, failing which his/her application will be rejected. Failure to sign will entail rejection of his/her application.
- (ii) Code No. of Post should be specified in column 23 of the OMR application and the Boxes thereunder shaded.
- (iii) Columns 11, 14(c) ,14(d) and 23(a) of the OMR application form need not be filled in.
- (iv) Columns 1, 1(a), 3, 4, 22 and 23 in the OMR application form filled up based on the details available in this Notification / Advertisement.
