#### **3. GENERAL INFORMATION :-**

- A. The rule of reservation of appointments is applicable to each post separately except for the post of Store Keeper and the distribution of the vacancies will be as per the rule in force.
- B. The number of vacancies advertised is only approximate and is liable for modification with reference to the vacancy position at any time before finalisation of selection for Oral Test or selection for appointment, as the case may be.
- C. If no qualified and suitable women candidates are available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, those vacancies will be filled by male candidates belonging to the respective communal categories.
- D. **Certificate of Physical Fitness:**  
Candidate selected for appointment to the post of Junior Architect in the Chief Architects Section of the o/o the Chief Engineer, PWD (General) should produce Certificate of Physical fitness in the form prescribed for Executive Post. Standard of Vision is Standard III or Better. Colour Blindness to be a disqualification.

A Candidate selected for appointment to posts of Computer-Cum- Vaccine Store Keeper in Public Health Department and Store Keeper in the Forensic Sciences Department shall produce Certificate of Physical fitness in the form prescribed for "Other than Executive Post and Posts in the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service, Tamil Nadu Judicial Ministerial Service and Tamil Nadu Secretariat Service" Standard of Vision is Standard III or Better. Colour Blindness and Night Blindness to be a disqualification

- E. The Physically Handicapped persons should produce a certificate of physical fitness from the Medical Board to the effect that his/her handicap will not render him/her incapable of efficiently discharging the duties attached to the post to which he/she has been selected before appointment. PH persons are eligible for 3% reservation for the post of Computer –Cum- Vaccine Storekeeper only. However no reserved turn for PH candidate arises.
- F. Reservation to "Ex - Serviceman & Destitute Widows" will apply only for the post of Computer-Cum- Vaccine Store Keeper. However no reserved turn for Ex-Serviceman arises.
- G. Any claim relating to the selection (not related to candidature or/and claims made in the application) should be received within 90 days from the date of announcement of results and any claim received thereafter will receive no attention.
- H. The expression B.C. (i.e. Backward Class) wherever occurs in the Commission's 'Instructions, etc. to candidates', Information Brochure, OMR application form, shall be read as B.C.(Other than BCMs), and B.C.(Muslim). Candidates belonging to BCMs should Compulsorily fill-up Columns 6,7 and 7(a) of the OMR application and shade the boxes there under. (BCM denotes Backward Class Muslims).
- I. All the concessions / relaxations / benefits applicable to BC candidates are applicable to BC Muslim candidates also.

#### 4. **QUALIFICATIONS:** -

##### (A) **AGE (as on 01.07.2009)**

- 1) Minimum age limit - Should have completed 18 years ( for all candidates)
- 2) Maximum age limit - Should not have completed 30 years.

##### **Note:**

1. No maximum age limit for SCs, STs, MBCs/DCs, BCs (Other than BCMs), BCMs and Destitute Widows of all castes, who have passed PTC/PUC/HSC/Diploma/ Degree.
2. Age relaxation of 5 years in the maximum age limit will be applicable to persons affected by the ban order as per the orders of the Government.
3. Candidates not belonging to SCs, STs, MBCs/DCs and BCs (Other than BCMs) and BCMs (i.e. others) who have put in five years of service in the State / Central Government are not eligible to apply even though they are within the age limit.
4. The Technical and Non-Technical Staff of TANSI who are facing retrenchment and have not been absorbed in the Government Corporations / Undertakings may also apply (evidence to be produced), if they satisfy all the prescribed qualifications except age. The relevant age rule will be relaxed by the Government in their favour if they come up for selection.

(i) The question paper in the subjects "Architecture" will be set in English only and for the other subjects the question paper will be set both in English and Tamil. (ii) The existing syllabus for the subject "Architecture" (Degree Standard) under Paper-I( 5 units) and paper- II ( 5 units) has been clubbed together and constituted as a single syllabus ( 10 units). (iii) A single question paper in the said syllabus is to be answered by the candidates in their respective subjects. (iv) Candidates should specify in column 22 under the heading optional subject 1 of the OMR application form, the subject in which they wish to answer. They should choose only the subject in which they have obtained the qualification. (v) The syllabi have been published in the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Bulletin No.11, dated 16.05.01 at the pages mentioned below against each.

**6. CENTRES FOR EXAMINATION:-**

Examination will be held at **CHENNAI** only (Centre Code No.001) Candidates should appear for the written examination and for Oral Test (If they are called) at their own expenses. The Commission reserves the right to increase the number of examination centre and to re-allot the candidates.

**7. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:-**

Selection will be made in two successive stages i.e., (i) Written Examination and (ii) Oral Test in the shape of an interview. Final selection will be made on the basis of the total marks obtained by the candidates at the Written Examination and Oral Test taken together, subject to the rule of reservation of appointments wherever applies. Candidates' appearance in the Written Examination and Oral Test is compulsory. A candidate who has not appeared for the Oral Test will not be considered for selection, even if he/she secures the qualifying marks for selection in the Written Examination (For further details please refer paragraph 22(b) of the 'Instructions etc. to candidates').

- 8. EXAMINATION FEE:- Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only)** Examination fee should be paid only through any one of the Post offices listed in Annexure – III to the Brochure and the Postal receipt obtained for the payment of fee should be pasted in the space provided in the application. (For further details refer para. 2 under part –III of Information Brochure and for Examination fee concessions, refer para 12 of the 'Instructions etc. to candidates'). All candidates should pay Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five only) as service charge to the Post Office, while obtaining the Postal receipt. Candidates (other than those who apply Online) should inform the OMR Application number to the Counter Clerk of the Post Office for obtaining the Postal receipt. **Physically Handicapped persons are exempted from payment of Examination fee irrespective of their family income. ( evidence for PH should be enclosed).**

**9.ENCLOSURES TO BE SENT ALONG WITH APPLICATION:-**

Candidates should enclose copies of all certificates (including evidence for Educational Qualification possessed by them) as mentioned in para 15 of the Commission's 'Instructions etc. to candidates' and item 25 under part – II of Information Brochure along with a Postal receipt to the value of Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only) pasted in the column provided in the application, unless exemption of fee is claimed. Information relating to debarment by any recruiting agency, criminal or any disciplinary proceeding initiated or finalised should be furnished along with the application. **Original Certificate should not be sent.** Those applying Online please refer sub para D of para 12 of this Notification / Advertisement.

**11.CONCESSIONS:-**

Concessions in the matter of age and/or qualification and/or fees allowed to SCs, STs, MBCs/DCs, BCs, BCMs, Destitute Widows, Ex-Servicemen, Physically Handicapped persons, Bonded Labourers, Discharged and serving temporary State Government employees below 40 years of age, etc. are given in the Commission's 'Instructions, etc. to candidates'. Concessions if any to be availed evidence has to be produced.

**12. ISSUE OF APPLICATION FORMS: -**

- A. OMR application forms can also be obtained in person from the Sales Counter of the office of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, Omanthoorar Government Estate, Chennai-600 002, on all the working days till the closing date upto 5.00 p.m. (Excluding lunch interval between 1.30 and 2.00 p.m.) only on cash payment of Rs.30/- (Rupees Thirty only). **Application forms will not be supplied to the candidates by Post.**
- C. Candidates should use only the OMR application form (AD or subsequent series). No other typed or printed or Xeroxed / Photocopy of the application form will be accepted and such application, if any received, will be summarily rejected.
- D. Candidates can also avail of the facility of applying Online on the Commission's Website at [www.tnpsc.gov.in](http://www.tnpsc.gov.in). Candidates applying Online should possess and keep ready Postal receipt for Rs.130/- (i.e. Application fee Rs.30/- and Examination fee Rs.100/-) obtained from any one of the Head Post Offices / selected Sub- Post Offices, listed in Annexure III of the Information Brochure before registering Online. Candidates claiming exemption from payment of Examination fee should possess and keep ready Postal receipt for Rs.30/- towards the application fee. The Postal receipt obtained for the payment of Application Fee/ Examination Fee should be pasted in the space provided in the application. Candidates applying Online shall also abide by the Commission's instructions laid down in this Notification / Advertisement/Commission's 'Instructions etc. to candidates'/ Information Brochure. Candidates applying Online should send the applications (i.e. The printout generated from the web site and **signed by the candidates**) with the Postal Receipt along with attested copies of Certificates so as to reach the Commission's office on or before the last date for receipt of applications, failing which his/her application will be rejected.   - (iii) Columns 11, 23 and 23(a) of the OMR application form need not be filled in.
  - (v) Columns 6, 7, 7(a) and 8 of OMR application are filled in and the Boxes there under shaded.
  - (vi) Candidates applying for the post under Post Code No. 1768 should send evidence for possessing practical experience and shade item 14 in column 25.
