 - (b) How will he proceed to confiscate the Red Sander logs with tools and vehicle? Mention in details about the relevant provisions. (20)
- 2. A farmer has raised 1000 sandal trees in his farm land. He wants to sell 200 trees attaining its silvi-cultural maturity. It happens in The Nilgiris, where HACA is applicable. Give details about the steps to be followed under various Acts and provisions to legally proceed in felling and sale of sandal trees. (15)

3. Difference between Reserve Forest and Community Forest and also the difference between National Park under conservation reserve. Give details about the process involved in notifying all of them. (15)
