In the letter third cited, the Secretary,  
Sri Sarada College of Physical Education, Salem has requested  
the Government to recognise the B.P.E.S. Degree for  
purpose of employment in Public Services, as the College  
is affiliated to Madras University.

2. I am directed to state that University of  
Madras is included in the list of Universities and  
Institutions recognised by the University Grants Commission  
for purpose of its grants and it has also been included  
in Schedule II of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu  
State and Subordinate Services. As such, with reference  
to the Rule 19 of the General Rules for Tamil Nadu State  
and Subordinate Services, the Degree of B.P.E.S. offered  
by the Sri Sarada College of Physical Education for Woman  
affiliated to University of Madras can be considered as a  
qualification for employment purpose.

3. I am further to state that the Secretary,  
Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has also informed that  
the committee in its meeting held on 3.1.96 resolved that  
there is no need to recommend the degrees and Diplomas

awarded by the Universities recognised by the Univ Grants Commission and by the State Board of Technical Education, Madras for recognition once again by the Government, since all the degrees and Diplomas were already awarded by the recognised universities and Boards.

4. I am therefore, directed to request you to instruct all the Employment Exchange Officers in the State of Tamil Nadu to give equal importance to the students who studied the B.P.E.S. Course in the above Institutions without any prejudice while sending the call letters to the respective student concerned for appointment in public services and who have registered their name in the respective Employment Exchange.
