





  - எல்லா வினாக்களுக்கும் விடையளிக்கவும். எல்லா வினாக்களும் சமமான மதிப்பெண்கள் கொண்டவை.
  - உங்களுடைய பதிவு எண்ணை இந்தப் பக்கத்தின் வலது மேல் மூலையில் அதற்கென அமைந்துள்ள இடத்தில் நீங்கள் எழுத வேண்டும். வேறு எதையும் வினாத்தொகுப்பில் எழுதக்கூடாது.
- விடைத்தாள் ஒன்று விடைகளை குறிப்பதற்கு அறைக்கண்காணிப்பாளரால் உங்களுக்கு வழங்கப்படும். விடைகளைக் குறிப்பது உள்ளிட்ட அவசியம் பின்பற்றப்பட வேண்டிய அறிவுரைகள் விடைத்தாளிலும், தோவுக்கூட அனுமதிச் சீட்டிலும் வழங்கப்பட்டுள்ளன.
- உங்களுடைய வினாத்தொகுப்பு எண்ணை (Question Booklet Number) விடைத்தாளின் முதல் பக்கத்தில் அதற்கென அமைந்துள்ள இடத்தில் <u>கருமை நிற மையுடைய பந்துமுனைப் பேனாவினால்</u> குறித்துக்காட்டவேண்டும். வினாத்தொகுப்பு எண்ணை விடைத்தாளில் சரியாகக் குறித்துக் காட்டத் தவறினாலோ அல்லது குறிக்கத் தவறினாலோ உங்களுடைய விடைத்தாள் செல்லாததாக்கப்படும்.
