Sub: Public Services-Preparation of panel for
appointment by promotion/Recruitment by
transfer - Further guidelines - Issued.

As per the first proviso to paragraph 4 II(2) of the letter second cited, if the Officer was imposed with any of the punishments within the check period for irregularities/delinquencies which occurred five years prior to the date of punishment, such punishment need not be held against him. On the suggestion of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, the Government have examined in detail the above norm and have decided that the date of occurrence of the irregularities/delinquencies should be reckoned from the crucial date and not from the date of punishment. Accordingly, the following amendment is issued to the letter second cited:-

AMENDMENT

The existing first proviso to paragraph 4 II (2) shall be substituted as follows:-

"Provided that if the officer was imposed with any of the punishments within the check period as mentioned above, for irregularities/delinquencies which occurred five years prior to the crucial date, such punishment need not be held against him".
