In Government order first read above, a committee has been constituted under the hairnanship of the Chairman, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission with the following Members to examine the requests of Educational Institutions to recognise the courses offered them for the purpose of appointment in Public Services:-

- (i). The Vice- Chancellor of the Madras University
- (ii) The Vice Chancellor of the Annamala University.
- (iii) The Secretary to Government of Tamil Nadu Personnel & Administrative Reforms Department,
- (iv). The Secretary to Government of Tamil Nadu, Education Department
- (v). The Director of Collegiate Education, Chernal.,
- (vi). The Director of Technical Education, Chennal,
- 2. Subsequently, in the Government Letter second read amendment to the Government Order first read above has been issued to the effect that the Chairman will convene the meeting once in a year or as and when necessity arises at his office and he will send the Committee's recommendations for recognition of such courses to the Government. The Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission will assist the Chairman in gathering the subject particulars for the meeting from the concerned Heads of Department / Administrative Departments of Government and include their views in the agenda so as to enable the Committee to get the benefit of these

views before it arrives at a final recommendation. He will also take necessary follow up action in implementing the decisions of the Committee...

- 3. The Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has now come up to the Government with the proposal that the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission who is assisting the Chairman of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission in the capacity as the Chairperson of the Equivalence Committee, may be designated as the Member Secretary of the Equivalence Committee.
- 4. He has also requested that necessary amendments to the Government order first read above may be issued by including the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission as Member Secretary of the Equivalence Committee.
- 5. The Government after careful examination has decided to accept the proposal of the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission and accordingly issue the following amendment to the Government order first read above.
